

- 32 V.S.A. §3113 prohibits any unit of State government from granting, issuing, or renewing "any license or other authority to conduct a trade or business (including a license to practice a profession)" to any person "unless such person shall first sign a written declaration under the pains and penalties of perjury that the person is in good standing with respect to or in full compliance with a plan to pay any and all taxes due as of the date such declaration is made[.]"

- 15 V.S.A. §795 requires every applicant for a license (defined as a license, certification, or registration issued by any unit of State government to conduct a trade or business, including a license to practice a profession) to sign a statement that the applicant is not subject to a child support order or if so subject, that the applicant is in good standing with child support or in full compliance with a plan to pay child support. "A license may not be issued or renewed without such a statement."

- 4 V.S.A. §1110 "Every applicant for a license shall sign a statement that the applicant is in good standing with respect to any unpaid judgment issued by the Judicial Bureau or Criminal Division of the Superior Court for fines or penalties for a violation or criminal offense. A license may not be issued or renewed without such a statement."

- 13 V.S.A. §7043a "Every applicant for a license shall sign a statement that the applicant is in good standing with respect to any restitution order. A license may not be issued or renewed without such a statement."
