Cindy Taylor-Patch presented findings pertaining to this assessment of fair and impartial policing-related training objectives including lesson plan information and Academy instructors' feedback pertaining to their content area (e.g. motor vehicle law, crash investigation, patrol procedures). Findings demonstrated a fair amount of interweaving of FIP concepts is already taking place, noting all instructors displayed a marked eagerness to include and/or expand FIP concepts in their content areas.
