All applicants must be **certified** police officers in the state of Vermont and currently, be employed by a Vermont law enforcement agency/department. A qualified Radar/Lidar instructor applicant must demonstrate proficiency in the use of Radar and Lidar instruments.

Each applicant will provide the Instructor Screening Committee with the following documents:

- Letter of recommendation from agency head (Chief/Sheriff/Station Commander).
Letter of recommendation from immediate supervisor, if different from agency head.
Any communication recognizing you for outstanding traffic work or testimony.
Any other document you feel will demonstrate your dedication to enforcement, public education, or community participation relating to traffic safety.

Radar/Lidar Instructor CRITERIA (some, but not all of the pre-requisites for applicants)

- ❖ Exceptional ability to understand, administer and articulate the use of Radar and Lidar instruments
- ❖ Exceptional verbal and written communication skills
- ❖ Ability and willingness to instruct other officers and recruits
- ❖ Support of applicant's Department /Agency to meet all requirements and responsibilities affiliated with being an instructor
- ❖ Outstanding history of performance enforcing traffic laws
- ❖ Commitment to the program for a minimum period of three (3) years.
- ❖ Solid community relations skills and the ability to work in partnership with the community you serve.
- ❖ Comfortable delivering presentations.
- ❖ Ability and willingness to participate in teaching two classes, at a minimum, every year
- ❖ Ability and willingness to complete recertification every two years

Instructor training includes:

- Radar/Lidar Instructor Development Course (IDC)
- Audit of all sections (16 hours) of the Core, Radar, and Lidar classes
- Teach all sections (16 hours) of the Core, Radar, and Lidar class
 - Auditing and teaching must be done within two years of the IDC

Radar/Lidar instructor certification is valid for one year initially and then two years. To maintain certification, instructors must teach at least two classes in a two-year period. A recertification form is required.

I have read the above requirements and understand the content. I feel I am both qualified and motivated to undergo this training and become an instructor. Understanding the requirements, I submit this request for an interview by the instructor screening panel.
